

Landfill receives \$2.2M

Gov. Dennis Daugaard says the state Board of Water and Natural Resources has approved a nearly \$2.2 million grant and loan package for Vermillion to expand its regional landfill.

The \$2,161,210 funding package includes a \$522,210 grant from the Solid Waste Management Program and a \$1,639,000 low-interest loan from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund Program.

The project involves constructing a new six-acre, solid-waste disposal cell that will provide landfill capacity to accept solid waste through 2020. The expansion project also includes constructing a leachate collection system and a one-million-gallon leachate storage pond.
