USD 5-1; Fort Wayne 2-5

FORT WAYNE, IN – The University of South Dakota's softball team split a pair of matches with first-place Fort Wayne Friday at IPFW Softball Field. The Coyotes (19-13, 2-3 Summit) won the opener 5-2, handing the Mastodons their third loss in the last 18 games. Fort Wayne (23-8, 4-1) took the nightcap 5-1. The rubber match starts at 10 a.m. (CDT) Saturday.

USD freshman Rachel Cue beat reigning Summit League Pitcher of the Week Miranda Kramer in the opening game. Cue (10-7) struck out nine, walked one and allowed eight

hits. Kramer (12-5), who hadn't allowed a run in her last 17 innings of work, was tagged for the second-most runs in an outing this season.

Matley Jones homered off Kramer in the fourth inning that tied the game at 1-1. It was the second home run of the year for Jones. Christine Broders gave USD a 3-2 lead in the sixth with a two-run single to left. Katie Cochran followed with a two-run triple down the right field line to complete a four-run inning.

Fort Wayne shortstop Alex Bousque led off the third inning with a solo shot to left. The

Mastodons later loaded the bases, but Cue caught Caitlyn DeLo looking to get out of the third.

Catcher Dani Pugh's sixth home run of the season put Fort Wayne back in front 2-1 in the fifth inning. Cue caught DeLo looking again to get out of a two-on, two-out jam. Cue retired seven of the final eight hitters she faced.

Broders had two hits in the opener and homered as one of three USD hits in game two. Broders and Cochran, who bat eighth and ninth, respectively, in the lineup, combined for five of USD's nine hits and five of the

team's six RBIs during the twin bill.

Pitcher Megan Flenniken (11-3) struck out a season-high 12 in game two for the Mastodons. Her lone blemish was the bomb by Broders to start the third inning. Flenniken has allowed four runs in her last 10 starts spanning 60 innings (0.46 ERA).

Fort Wayne scored twice in the first and third innings and added a fifth run in the fifth. Audrey Minta had two doubles and three RBIs for the Mastodons. Fort Wayne had nine hits in the contest.

McKelvey breaks collegiate state record at Wildcat Classic

WAYNE, NE – Kyle McKelvey set a new state collegiate men's outdoor shot put record while Tevaskie Lewin (men's 110 meters), Alex Hohenthaler (men's 5,000) and Breanna Janovy (women's discus) all added wins at the Wildcat Classic hosted by Wayne State on Saturday.

McKelvey won the shot put with a mark of 59 feet, 5 1/2 inches, breaking the previous state record of 59-4 1/4 that he set at the Summit League Outdoor Track and Field Championships last May.

The mark is the best in the league this season and was over five feet better than second place Zachery Lurz of Concordia (54-5 1/4). USD's Dustin Valind placed fourth with a mark of 50-6 3/4.

Lewin won the 110 hurdles in 14.26 seconds while Hohenthaler won the 5,000 in 15:29.89. Lewin's time is the fastest in the league this season while Hohenthaler topped teammate Isaac Allen, who placed second with a time of 15:31.31.

The Coyote men also received second place finishes from Tyler Frank in the high jump (6-6 3/4) and Connor Fitzsimmons in the triple jump (45-6 1/2). Christian Nielsen added a third place finish in the 100 (10.82).

Janovy took the women's discus title with a career-best mark of 156-8, which ranks as the best mark in the league so far this outdoor season. Danielle Waldner placed second in the shot put (45-8), Meghan Dennis was third in the javelin (138-3) and Briquella Bowden was third in the high jump (5-1) to round out USD's top finishes in field events.

On the track, Amber Ewers had a pair of top-three finishes, finishing second in the 400 (58.17) and third in the 200 (25.97). Megan Hilson placed second in the 1,500 (4:50.30), Tansha Clarke was second in the 100 hurdles (14.94) and the 4x100 relay of Courtney Albrecht, Ravan Kott, Clarke and Molly Ervin rounded out USD's top-

three finishers by placing third in 49.52.

USD also competed at the Texas Relays this past weekend and finished competition on Friday. Emily Brigham placed 10th (12-7 1/2) and Hunter Wilkes was 12th (12-1 1/2) in section B of the women's pole vault to round out USD's competitors at that meet.

USD track and field will compete at the Dakota Duals in Yankton next weekend.
