## John F. Bryde II

John F. Bryde II was born Aug. 4, 1920, near Augusta, KS, in an area of the oil fields known as Haskins Camp. He received his elementary and high school education in Wichita, KS. Three months after grad-

uating from Cathedral High School in 1938, Bryde joined the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) where he spent the next 30 years of his life; 17 of these years in the Roman Catholic priesthood. During this time, he spent 23 years on the Pine Ridge Reservation (Sioux) in western South Dakota. He started as a high school teacher, then was assigned to missionary work for several years, caring for seven churches covering an area approximately 40 miles by 90 miles.

In 1955, he was appointed superintendent of Red Cloud Indian School of the Holy Rosary Mission, at that time the nation's largest mission school, with 531 children in grade school and high school. Here he spent his last 13 years on the Reservation. During these years, he learned the Sioux language fluently and eventually had a weekly radio program in the Sioux language that was aired over 13 stations in the

Midwest, including the city of Denver.

At this time, he also earned a doctorate degree in psychology and developed a new field known as Acculturational Psychology which was eventually adopted by many colleges and universi-

In 1968, he changed his priestly life-style, adding marriage to the priesthood. He married Melanie Hondel and moved his Indian ministry to the University of South Dakota at Vermillion, where he continued working with the Indian people, developing two distinctive programs in higher education for Indian people: 1) Institutes for teachers of Indian students in which such teachers were trained in Indian values in order to better understand their Indian students and, thereby, to do a more effective teaching job, and 2) Doctoral programs for Indian people with master's degrees by which Native Americans could earn a doctoral major in Indian Educa-

He is the author of six books and 23 journal articles. Bryde and his wife, Melanie, have three children: Melanie, Bonnie and John III.

Survivors include his wife, Melanie (nee Hondel); daughters, Melanie (Justin) Morrill, Seattle, WA, Bonnie (Matthew) Malmberg, Stillwater, MN, and John Francis Bryde III (Stacey), Minneapolis, MN; seven grandchildren; and one sister, Mary Talevich, San Luis Obispo, CA; and one brother, Michael Bryde, Tucson, AZ.

The South Dakota Department of "There is both an immediate and future Labor (DOL) has partnered with the Regional Technical Education Center (RTEC) at Yankton to expand the stickwelding program and upgrade the computer numerical control (CNC) machin-

DOL provided RTEC \$11,000 to purchase five more stick-welding machines and \$77,668 for the CNC machining program to purchase seven computers, more advanced software, two lathes and a three-dimensional printer.

Workers who have lost their jobs can learn valuable new skill sets through either of these programs," said State Labor Secretary Pam Roberts.

Introduction to Stick Welding is a 40-hour course that will now have room tify and enroll in workforce training for up to 13 students. New classes start monthly. The course teaches the principles of Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW). Upon completion of the class, students can take the American Welding Society (AWS) certification test.

The CNC machining class began June 30 and is 210 hours long. It has incorporated new technology and green concepts used in advanced manufacturing. The next class begins in Janu-

ary and will take up to 23 students. "Laid-off workers may each be eligi-

ble for up to \$5,200 in tuition assistance from DOL," said Secretary Roberts. "Our staff is available to help workers idenopportunities leading to new careers."

To determine eligibility for tuition assistance, DOL considers workers' current employment status, need to learn new technologies to find good jobs and determination to support themselves and their families.
