AUSTIN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

KINDERGARTEN:

- 1 – Set headphones for computer use (Please place in plastic bag and label with child's name)
- 1 – Large backpack or book bag (to fit boots or shoes and winter wear, as well as important papers, library books, etc.)
- 2 – Double-pocket folders large enough for 9" x 12" papers (bottom pocket is better than side pockets.)
- Spiral-bound notebook, approximately 8" x 10" and 70 pages (to be used as writing journal)
- 2 – Standard #2 pencils (may need to be replaced later)
- Large pink or green eraser (cute ones don't work well)
- 4 – Glue sticks (may need to be replaced frequently)
- 2 – Bottles of white school glue 4 oz. (blue gel or no-run glue or Ross brand are NOT recommended! They are difficult to squeeze and clog the caps worse than standard Elmer's)
- Scissors (small metal Fiskars with plastic handles work best and will last for years)
- 1 – Box of 16-24 crayons, standard colors and size (unless your child prefers large)
- 1 – Set of watercolor paints, 8 colors including black (Prang brand is especially good)
- 2 – Dry erase markers
- 1 – Box facial tissues

GRADE 1:

- 1 – Set headphones (Please place in plastic bag with both labeled with child's name – no earbuds please)
- 1 – 8 oz. Elmer's white school glue
- 2 – Glue sticks
- Crayons (maximum 24 count)
- 4 – Dry erase markers (Expo work best)
- 1 – Set of watercolor paints
- 1 – Set of colored pencils
- 1 – Black Sharpie marker
- 2 – Highlighters (any color)
- 1 – Box of tissues
- 10 – #2 lead pencils (sharpened – no decorative pencils)
- 1 – School box
- Large pink or green eraser (cute erasers do not work)
- Scissors (small Fiskars work the best)
- 2 – Spiral bound notebooks (wide rule)
- Large backpack or school bag (No rollers "please")
- 2 – Boxes snack crackers to share (saltines, Ritz, graham, etc.)
- 1 – Container antibacterial wipes (for SURFACES)
- 3 – 2 Pocket Folders
- Washable markers

SIXTH GRADE:

- 1 large trapper keeper with 5 trapper folders and pencil bag
 - Loose leaf notebook paper for the year
 - Pencils – enough for the year
 - Flash drive – 2g marked with the student's name
 - Colored pencils
 - 1 – two pocket folder with fasteners for Language Arts
- The following items should be purchased and given to the first period teacher:*
- 1 – glue stick
 - 1 – box pencils - 12 count
 - 2 – red pens
 - 1 – highlighter
 - 2 – LARGE boxes of tissues

SEVENTH GRADE:

- 2 – highlighters
 - 1 – large trapper
 - Colored pencils
 - Large eraser
 - Composition Notebook
 - Loose leaf paper for all classes
 - 6 – colored folders
 - Flash drive - 2g
 - 5 – one subject notebooks
- The following items should be purchased and given to the first period teacher*
- 2 – glue sticks
 - Lined index cards, 200 count
 - 1 – box pencils, 12 count
 - Pens: 3-blue and 2-red
 - 2 LARGE boxes of tissues

EIGHTH GRADE:

- 1 – three inch binder
- 4 – binder dividers with pockets
- Lined, loose-leaf notebook paper for the year
- Colored pencils
- 1 – box of 12 #2 lead pencils
- 2 – dry erase markers
- Glue stick
- 1 – pair of scissors
- 1 – large eraser
- TI-34II Scientific calculator
- Composition Notebook for English
- 2 – LARGE boxes of tissues (please turn these into 1st period teacher)

ENCORE CLASSES:

- **Art** – This is required for all grades: drawing pencil set containing 2b-3b-4b with erasers, 1 fine point sharpie marker, 1 art gum eraser
- **Band:** Pencils
- **Music** – 6th grade: Spiral notebook, 2 pocket folder, 1 large box tissues
- **Physical Education:** Gym shorts and a t-shirt, Extra pair of shoes (to be kept at school in their gym locker)
- **Techmods:** 6th grade – will need a ruler in inches, not centimeters, 1 two-pocket folder, pencils
7th grade – 1 two-pocket folder and pencils

GRADE 2:

- 1 – Set of headphones (put in baggie & label with name)

- 1 – Large box facial tissues

- 4 – Folders (NO TRAPPER KEEPERS)
- Scissors (5")
- Small pencil box (8 x 6 x 3)
- 1 – Backpack or school bag
- 1 – Box of colored pencils
- Headphones (put in baggie & label with name)

GRADE 4:

- Crayons (box of 16)
- 1 – Loose leaf paper (3/8" spacing)
- 8 – Pencils with #2 lead (Mechanical pencils preferred)
- 2 – Red pens
- Erasers for pencils
- 2 – Large boxes facial tissue
- 1 – Small box of colored pencils
- 10 – 2-pocket folders (NO TRAPPER KEEPERS) – One will be used of Music Class
- Scissors (5")
- 1 – School glue sticks
- 4 – Spiral notebooks (wide spacing)
- Small pencil box (8 x 6 x 3)
- 4 – Large dry erase makers
- Headset earphones for Computer
- 1 – 1" 3-ring binder
- 1 Set/box of multiplication flash cards

GRADE 5:

- Markers and colored pencils
- 12 – 16 Pencils (#2 lead)
- 1 – Ruler (12")
- 6 – 2-pocket folders – One will be used for Music Class
- Scissors (5")
- 2 – Glue sticks
- Spiral notebook for Journal Writing
- 2 – Packages of loose leaf paper
- 2 – Large boxes of facial tissue
