The South Dakota Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) has received an application for the issuance of a Surface Water Discharge (SWD) permit from the following applicant:

The renewal of the Surface Water Discharge permit will allow the discharge of treated wastewater from the City of Vermillion's wastewater treatment facility. Any discharge from this facility will enter VERMILLION RIVER. VERMILLION RIVER has been assigned the following beneficial uses:

- (5) Warm water semipermanent fish life propagation waters;
- (8) Limited-contact recreation waters;
- (9) Fish and wildlife propagation, recreation and stock watering waters;
- (10) Irrigation waters; and

Tentative determinations regarding the water quality limits for any discharge and other conditions have been made by DENR. The Surface Water Discharge permit specifies the quality of water that can be discharged and still protect the uses of the receiving water. The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday, August 14, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. Members present: Powell, Kephart, Wilson, Passick and Packard.

Kephart moved, seconded by Passick and carried to approve the agenda with the addition of county plaque item.

Minutes of the August 7, 2012 meeting were approved with a motion by Wilson seconded by Packard and carried.

Ashley Strochein/Department of Legislative Audit met with the Board to present the engagement letter for providing the county's audit for years 2010 & 2011. Passick moved, seconded by Packard and carried to authorize the Chairman to sign said engagement.

A fireworks permit was submitted on Behalf of Tom Taylor for firework display at the Bull-O-Rama-Coyote Rodeo grounds slated for August 25th. With the dry conditions, Burn Ban in force, and no rain in site, it died for lack of second.

Steve Mietz-Missouri National Recreation River Superintendent met with the Board and presented Commissioner Wilson with a Special Award for his outstanding river stewardship for the Park Service and as a valued supporter of the Wild & Scenic River.

The Board discussed the courthouse centennial celebration and what type of plaque will be created for the event. Wilson moved, seconded by Packard and carried to approve the plaque to be mounted inside the courthouse with wording and picture defined when draft is presented according to quote received from Print Source.
