 Commissioner Meeting

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday, August 13, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. Members present: Kephart, Mockler, Packard, Passick, and Powell.

Kephart moved, seconded by Mockler and carried to approve the agenda as presented.  
 Minutes of the August 6th meeting were approved with a motion by Mockler seconded by Packard and carried.

Jane Norling, Beresford Public Library, met with the Board to request funding for 2014 because the library serves Clay County residents. Powell moved, seconded by Mockler and carried to approve a change in the 2014 Provisional Budget to allow for a \$1500 allocation to the Beresford Public Library.

The Board had a public hearing at 9:10 a.m., the time set for consideration of a three day malt beverage license for Coyote Country Rodeo Club at the Clay County Park Rodeo Arena on August 23, 24, and 25. No one appeared in objection to the license and no written letters of opposition were received. Powell moved, seconded by Kephart to approve the application and grant the license, but let the minutes reflect that the Board would like the Rodeo Club to clear the right-of-way of any litter caused as a result of the license. Motion carried.

Rod Polley, Highway Superintendent, met with the Board to discuss a driveway removal on 302 St. Powell moved, seconded by Mockler and carried to approve the driveway removal at the landowner's expense.

At 9:15 a.m., bid opening commenced for the Baptist Creek Bank Stabilization Project. Kevin Goff, Clark Engineering, assisted with reading the bids.

3-D Digging & Trucking, LLC: Base Bid \$177,965.10 and Base Bid Plus Alternate \$239,547.60  
 Pollman Excavation Inc.: Base Bid \$152,783.23 and Base Bid Plus Alternate \$213,039.93

The Board allowed time for Goff and Polley to tabulate bids, confirming that the amounts were correct.

At 9:45 a.m., Powell moved, seconded by Mockler and carried to recess for the Eagle Creek Software Services groundbreaking ceremony.

At 10:45 a.m. the meeting was reconvened.

Kevin Goff, Clark Engineering, and Rod Polley, Highway Superintendent returned from tabulating bids. A math error on the bid from Runge Enterprises, Inc. was found and corrected per the bid procedures. The total for Base Bid was found to be \$150,319.55 and Base Bid Plus Alternate was \$206,900.41. Powell moved, seconded by Packard and carried to award the Base Bid Plus Alternate to Runge Enterprises, Inc. and ad-

Discussion commenced regarding the Courthouse Chiller Replacement Project. John Prescott, City of Vermillion City Manager, and Matt Betzen, City of Vermillion Police Chief were present for the discussion. It was reported that Clay County Deputy State's Attorney Philip Terwilliger could not find enough supporting evidence that The Cooperative Purchasing Network option previously considered by the Board would adequately satisfy all bid statutes. Therefore, Mockler moved, seconded by Powell to pursue putting the project to bid for like equipment, with a possible alternate option for additional equipment for areas within the Safety Center. Upon vote of the Commissioners, Powell, Mockler and Kephart voted Aye; Packard voted Nay. The motion passed.

Powell moved, seconded by Kephart and carried to set Tuesday, September 3, 2013 at 9:30 a.m. as the time for public hearing regarding the 2014 Provisional Budget.

Packard moved, seconded by Kephart and carried to authorize the Chairman to sign approval of the updated County zoning maps.

Mockler moved, seconded by Packard and carried to pass and adopt the following resolution approving Resolution #13-15 for transfer of funds from Restricted to the General Fund.
