AUSTIN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

-Pre-School-

- 1 - Regular sized backpack (big enough for folder)
- 2 - 2 pocket folders
- 1 - Pair of headphones (NO EARBUDS PLEASE)
- 1 - Set of watercolor paints (Prang or Crayola work best)
- 4 - Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 - Large box of tissues
- 1 - Pack of wet (baby) wipes

-Junior Kindergarten-

- 1 - Nice size backpack
- 1 - 4oz. bottle of glue
- 6 - Glue Sticks
- 1 - Box of crayons (16 - 24)
- 2 - Large boxes of Kleenex
- Watercolor paints (please write child's name on it)
- One plastic two pocket folder (please write name on upper right hand corner)
- A hard plastic pencil box
- Towel or Kindermat for rest time (first semester only)
- Pack of dry erase markers
- Water bottle sent to school daily (with child's name clearly labeled)
- Extra set of clothes for spills or accidents in labeled gallon sized Ziploc baggie (pants, shirt, underwear, and socks)

-Kindergarten-

- 1 - Set headphones for computer use (Please place in plastic bag & label with child's name - NO EARBUDS PLEASE)
- 1 - Large backpack or book bag (to fit boots or shoes & winter wear, as well as important papers, library books, etc.)
- 2 - Double-pocket folders large enough for 9" x 12" papers (bottom pocket is better than side pockets.)
- Spiral bound notebook, approximately 8" x 10" & 70 pages (to be used as writing journal)
- 2 - Sharpened standard #2 pencils (may need to be replaced later)
- Large pink eraser (cute ones don't work well)
- 4 - Glue sticks (may need to be replaced frequently)
- 2 - Bottles of white school glue 4oz. (blue gel or no-run glue or Ross brand are not recommended. They are difficult to squeeze and clog the caps worse than standard Elmer's)
- Scissors (small metal Fiskars with plastic handles work best and will last for years)
- 1 - Box of 16-24 crayons, standard colors & size (unless your child prefers large)
- 1 - Set of markers (box)
- 1 - Set of colored pencils
- 1 - Set of watercolor paints, 8 colors including black (Prang brand is especially good)
- 2 - Black dry erase markers
- 2 - Box facial tissues
- Change of clothes

-Grade 1-

- 1 - Set of headphones (Please place in plastic bag; label headphones & bag with child's name - NO EARBUDS PLEASE)
- 20 - #2 Lead pencils (sharpened-Mega brand or Ticonderoga work best)
- 2 - Large pink erasers OR package of pencil top erasers
- 8 - Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 - 24ct. box of crayons
- 1 - Set of colored pencils
- 1 - 8ct. box of washable markers (primary colors)
- 4 - Expo dry erase markers (2 wide & 2 fine point)
- 1 - Set of watercolor paints (Crayola or Prang work best)
- 2 - Highlighters (and color)
- 1 - Scissors (small Fiskars work the best)
- 3 - Boxes of tissue
- 1 - School box (plastic box to hold pencils, scissors, glue sticks, etc.)
- 2 - Spiral bound notebooks (wide ruled)
- 3 - 2 pocket folders
- 1 - Containers of Clorox wipes (for surfaces) not hand wipes
- 1 - 1" 3-ring binder (with clear plastic pocket front - any color)
- Large backpack (no rollers please)
