Vermillion Schools Welcome Students With Many Facility & Technology Improvements

Student registration for the new school year will be held at all schools on Monday and Tuesday, August 10 and 11, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The school is pleased to announce that all fees are the same as last year. Payment for meals may be made at the individual schools during registration. Also, free and reduced meal applications are available at the schools. Bus passes and activity tickets may be purchased at the district office. Activity tickets may also be purchased at the high school office.

Teachers will have meetings on Monday and Tuesday, August 17 and August 18 in preparation for the beginning of school. The first day of school will be Wednesday, August 19, which will be a full day of school. All services will be provided beginning the first day including transportation and meal programs.

Parents are encouraged to update telephone and e-mail contact information during registration. This information will be used to assist in communication with parents regarding school matters or in case of emergency. Also, contact information will be used with the SchoolReach System whereby weather and school schedule changes may be communicated directly to families.

Major facility projects this summer included complete upgrade of the high school heating, ventilation and air-conditioning systems. This \$5.2 million project will improve the learning atmosphere by providing consistent and efficient heating and cooling of classrooms. In addition, new windows, lighting, and ceilings have been installed. All classrooms and offices have also been painted. Chemistry and biology classrooms have also been renovated as well as the restrooms. As always, maintenance personnel have been hard at work cleaning, waxing, and painting throughout the summer in

preparation for a new school year.

The Vermillion School Board is committed to providing the latest technology for students and staff. New iPads will again be disseminated to all high school students at the beginning of the school year offering a one-to-one technology environment. A \$25.00 fee is required by the first day of school for the iPads from high school students. In addition to the new iPads, the middle school will have additional iPad carts. Each elementary classroom will receive additional iPads for student use. Audio-enhancement systems are in place in all elementary classrooms as well as in various classrooms in the middle school. Also, new projectors have been installed in all classrooms. One computer lab at the middle school has been upgraded with new computers.

The American Bus Corporation begins its sixth year of service to students and families in the school district with Shayne Ludwig as general manager. Rural parents of students new to the school system who wish to ride the bus should contact Shayne at 605-659-0178 or 624-8888. The transportation service offers modern route and activity buses. American Bus Corporation also has a mini-bus to provide safe and accessible transportation for special needs students.
