Move To 9AA Doesn't Change Goals For Traditional Power

TYNDALL – The Bon Homme Cavaliers move down from Class 11B and into Class 9AA football this season and have to adjust to a new style

of football. There is a lot more space on the field and a lot more responsibility defensively," senior fullback and linebacker Carter Mecham said. "I think our coaches are good and I'm confident they can get us into the right spots to get the job done.

Head coach Byron Pudwill and his staff will have their hands full making the transition from 11-man football to 9-man football. Nine-man teams will typically take out the two tackles on the offensive line for offense and take out either two players from the front seven or one player
