November 24, 2009 Commissioners Meeting The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday, November 24, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. Members present: Sommersvold, Powell, Kephart, Passick and Wilson.

Sommersvold moved, seconded by Kephart and carried to approve the agenda with the addition of the discussion item, Pictometry EAP Program. Minutes of the November 9th meeting were read, and approved with a motion by Passick, seconded by Wilson and carried. During visitor's to be heard: Wade Larson met with the Board to discuss the cleaning of County Road Ditch on 454 Ave. (Timber Road) in Section 20, Meckling Twp. It was the consensus of the Board that Mike Pollman be allowed to clean this section, under the guidance of the Highway Superintendent, to the level of the current, using a laser, at the cost of the landowner. Rod Polley/ Highway Superintendent met with the Board to discuss highway matters. Kephart moved, seconded by Passick and carried to approve the payment of \$21,759.52 to the DOT on Project NH0050(64)-388-6436 County Line Road.

Fuel quotes for unleaded gasoline were reviewed. Sommersvold moved, seconded by Passick and carried to approve the relief requested in the petition filed by Jerry's Service, Hardington, NE at \$2.372 per gal for 1600 gal. It was reported that the county bridge located on 298th and 461 Ave. in Riverside Township has been removed and the necessary signage and dike repair has been completed. The Vermillion City Library Report for October 2009 was accepted and placed on file. Ray Hofman/Zoning, Welfare and Veterans Administrator met with the Board. Passick moved, seconded by Wilson and carried to approve the travel expenses paid for by the Veterans Office at County Mini Conference in Pierre Nov.30th thru Dec 1st.
