Capital Improvements Fund - Provides resources for the purpose of purchasing buildings, or other facilities, equipment, and land, or for the construction or major renovation of buildings and other facilities. Student Financial Aid - Provides resources for financial aid to VHS graduates going on to post-secondary study. Special Projects Fund - Provides funding for projects, programs, activities or equipment that will enhance education for students in the Vermillion School District but that cannot be supported through any other fund. Professional Development Fund - Provides funding for school district personnel to obtain professional development that is unavailable otherwise. Later in 2006 a group of Vermillion citizens, with the support of the Vermillion School Board, began the process of establishing and organizing the Vermillion Public Schools Foundation. In early 2009 the foundation was officially recognized as a 501(c)(3) public charity by the IRS, making donations to the Foundation tax deductible.
