The 39th USD Winter Commencement honors more than 500 graduates

A sea of graduates, garbed in both red and black-those completing bachelor's degrees and master's or doctorate degrees, respectivelyalong with the friends and family members thereof filled the Dakota Dome this Saturday for the 39th USD Winter Commencement Exercises.

More than 500 graduates were conferred degrees by USD at this year's winter session commencement exercises, marking the ever-important transition between one's status as a student and the next step in the graduate's life.

"I'm pretty excited [to graduate]," said Emily Theisen, who received a master of science degree in occupational therapy. "It has been a long journey getting here. I've become really close with all my

classmates, and I'm really looking forward to what tomorrow brings."
