Notice is given that Howard A Kathol, 30918 450th Ave, Gayville SD 57031 has filed an application for a water permit to appropriate an additional 0.28 cubic feet of water per second (cfs) and irrigate 95 additional acres to what is currently authorized by Water Right No. 7030-3. Water Right No. 7030-3 appropriates 1.34 cfs from one well completed into the Lower James:Missouri Aquifer (162 feet deep) located in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27 to irrigate 115 acres located in the NW Section 27; all T94N-R53W. This application proposes to divert an additional 0.28 cfs from the existing well to irrigate 95 additional acres located in the NW 1/4 Section 27 and E 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 28; all in T94N-R53W. This application, if approved, and Water Right No. 7030-3 will authorizes a total diversion of 1.62 cfs for irrigation of 210 acres.

Pursuant to SDCL 46-2A-2, the Chief Engineer recommends AP-PROVAL of Application No. 7510-3 because 1) unappropriated water is available, 2) existing rights will not be unlawfully impaired, 3) it is a beneficial use of water, and 4) it is in the public interest. In accordance with SDCL 46-2A-23, the Chief Engineer will act on this application, as recommended, unless a petition is filed opposing the application or the applicant files a petition contesting the Chief Engineer's recommendation. The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session January 15, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. Members present: Mockler, Pas-

Minutes of the January 08, 2013 meeting were approved with a motion by Powell, seconded by Packard and carried.

The Vermillion Library Report for December was accepted and placed on file.

Jill Munger/Community Health Nurse met with the Board. The Quarterly Report for Oct., Nov., and Dec. 2012 was presented. WIC Client numbers have dropped slightly from last quarter. Immunizations are down from last quarter, but the number of flu shots currently is just one short of the entire number for last year, so numbers will be up significantly by the end of flu season due to the current flu epidemic. The Clay/Union POD group dispensed 640 flu vaccines in 4 hours during the October exercise.
