The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session January 29, 2013 at 9:00 a.m. Members present: Mockler, Passick, Kephart, Powell and Packard.

Mockler moved, seconded by Powell and carried to approve the agenda as amended with an executive session for personal matters added.

Minutes of the January 15, 2013

Cynthia Aden/Zoning Director met with the Board to discuss zoning and welfare matters. Keith Gestring and Jose Dominguez/City of Vermillion Engineer were present for the meeting.

There was discussion on a letter from Keith and Sheila Gestring that was submitted for a request of reimbursement, due to conflict on zoning rules in the joint jurisdiction. With the conflict of rules, Gestring's were required to relocate the building. The Gestring's are asking for \$3,250.00 which was incurred due to relocating said building.

Powell moved, seconded by Packard and carried to turn over request to Claims Associates (Clay County's Insurance Company) with the request that this valid claim be split between City of Vermillion and Clay County.
