8 Tanager grapplers heading to State

LENNOX – Vermillion placed third in the Region 2A wrestling tournament by qualifying eight athletes to make the long trek to Rapid City for State. After the first day of competition on Feb. 20, only Brett Culver (126 pounds) and Adam Winslow (285 pounds) had been eliminated, leaving many opportunities for Tanagers to advance.

Feb. 21 started with a full round of wrestle-backs. Of the six Tanagers fighting to earn the right to continue, only Carter Kratz (132 pounds) and Brandon Hertz (160 pounds) were able to win their matches. They both pinned their opponents in the second period.

With six wrestlers competing in the championship matches, that guaranteed that eight Tanagers would finish in the top four places and qualify for the State A meet in Rapid City Feb. 28 and Mar. 1.

The finals started out on the right path for the Tanagers when second-seeded Trey Hage upset top-seeded Cole Halouska of Lennox in the 106-pound championship. Hage was able to maintain control throughout the match to win 11-5 and secure a top seed at the state meet.

The 113-pound championship was again a matchup between Vermillion and Lennox. This time the Orioles' Wesley Weschedel beat Kyle Seibel of the Tanagers in a close 7-4 match.

The consolation match (for third place) at 132-pounds found Vermillion's Carter Kratz pinning Brandon Valley's Jackson Pletten in the second period.

The 145-pound final pitted Dakota Valley's Blake Perryman against Vermillion's Regan Bye in a rematch of the Dakota XII Conference championship. Unfortunately, Perryman won a defensive 3-2 decision to take top honors. Regan may very well get a chance to avenge both the losses to Perryman at State.

The 152-pound championship again found a Bye battling a Panther from Dakota Valley. This time, Brett Bye seemed to be toying with Brady Dam until boredom set in and Dam was pinned abruptly. Brett is now headed to State with a 44-

0 record, and a great chance to improve on his third-place finish from last year.

Vermillion's Brandon Hertz pinned Yankton's Ryan Stenhagen in the 160-pound consolation championship. Stenhagen was Hertz's fourth pin of the day, surprising the entire team when he was awarded the Region 2A Pinning Award. This is an award given out the wrestler with the most pins in the least amount of time.

Alex Osborne took on Sioux Falls Washington's Dorian Simpson in the 170-pound championship. After six

minutes of frantic action, Simpson prevailed with an 8-3 decision.

Seth Heine contested Sioux Falls Washington's Caleb York in the 182-pound final. The back-and-forth action was suddenly ended when, in the second period, York caught Heine off balance for a pin.

If you lost count, the eight Tanagers competing in the State A tournament are: Trey Hage (106), Kyle Seibel (113), Carter Kratz (132), Regan Bye (145), Brett Bye (152), Brandon Hertz (160), Alex Osborne (170) and Seth Heine (182).

Tanagers are beaten again by Madison Bulldogs

The Tanagers lost to the Madison Bulldogs for the second time this month, but this time it was by a mere seven points. This still leaves the Bulldogs as the only undefeated team in all three classes of boys' basketball in South Dakota.

"Our guys worked hard against the top ranked team in the state, but we just did not take care of the ball well enough to beat a team of Madison's caliber," Coach Jay Drake said.

The Tanagers were led by Tyrell Harper with 26 points, eight rebounds, four steals and two assists. Nick Jensen added 12

points, nine rebounds and two steals.

"We battled, and we believe that we became a better basketball team because of this game," said Drake, "and now we have to just keep moving forward and prepare for a very difficult game against Canton to end the regular season and to prepare us

for the post-season."

Cooper Williams scored eight points, grabbed two rebounds and had four assists. Carter Andre had seven points, two rebound and one steal. Jayce Huska added six points, two boards, one steal and four assists. Jeremiah Johnson had one rebound, while Paul Schwasinger had one steal.

The Tanagers (15-4) travel to Canton (15-4) on Feb. 28 to finish the regular season, and an important Region 4A matchup. They will then have to get ready for the Regionals, and hopefully the State A tournament, where Vermillion may get the chance to avenge the losses to Madison.
