Ed Clancy and Joe Shelby are reporters for The Paris Star, an English-language newspaper based in Paris. Survivors of missions to Vietnam, Beirut, Kosovo, and beyond, they are in shock at being ambushed by the Internet age and a 24-hour news cycle. "The Paris Correspondent," by author Alan S. Cowell, is a tribute to journalism, love and liquor in a turbulent era.

East coast transplants to a small Oregon town, Naomi and Scanlon Pratt are on the threshold of a new life. Scanlon has a position at a local University and Naomi, a fragrance designer whose sense of smell has inexplicably vanished, is expecting the couple's first child.
