The Tanagers hosted the Huskies from Elk Point-Jefferson in girls' basketball action on Jan. 21.

The Tanagers had two players score in double-figures, while the Huskies only had one.

Unfortunately, EPJ's Keely Bertram scored just under half of her team's points with 33.

"The Bertram girl really hurt us," said Coach Jon Brooks. "If we keep her in check, I really believe we put ourselves in a position to be in the game in the 4th. She is a great player, and she showed that tonight."

The Tanagers were led by Josie Huber with 18 points, 8 rebounds, two assists, and four steals. Haleigh Melstad scored 13 points, grabbed two boards, one steal and one assist.

"We got off to a bit of a slow start, but had a really good second quarter to only be down 1 at half," said Brooks. "In the second half their pressure started to wear us out and we just couldn't get much going offensively."

Twila Sweeney had 5 points and two rebounds. Tori Gregoire scored 4 points, grabbed two boards, and one steal. Kyleigh Melstad added 4 points, five rebounds and a steal.

Sydney Peters had 4 points, two rebounds and one steal. Rachel Finnegan scored one point and had one assist.

"We need to do a better job of getting into our offense and running it. When we did that in the second quarter we were very successful, but against a good team like EPJ you need to do it the whole game."

The Huskies scored 8 more points than the Tanagers from the free-throw line, and 14 more points from two-point range. T

he Tanagers had one more three-pointer than the Huskies in the losing effort.

"One thing I really like about our team is our effort," said Brooks. "Our kids play hard all the time and that will pay off for us in the long run."

The Tanagers host Lennox (4-5) on Jan. 24, then travel to West Central (6-2) on Jan. 28 before hosting Dell Rapids (4-4) on Jan. 30.

VHS gymnasts qualify for State

MADISON – The Tanager gymnastics team traveled to Madison on Jan. 18 to compete in the 8-team Madison Invitational. Scoring 112.2 points, they placed 7th with two new faces on the varsity team.

"Team and individual scores were low at this meet," said Coach Skye Bork, "but we are hoping that we can come together and perform in Yankton on Thursday. Thursday's meet and our meet on Feb. 3 against Wagner and West Central will be the our last regular season meets this year."

The two new varsity members are Sydney Tigert, who competed in the all-around, and Payton Larson, who

competed in the floor exercise.

"Both gymnasts did an outstanding job stepping in at the last minute for such a large invitational," said Bork.

Carter Williams placed 8th on beam and floor. Anneliese Taggart, Carter Williams, and Anna Hammond have qualifying scores, but need to use the next two meets to solidify their trip to the state individual day before they head to regions.

Gymnasts can qualify by placing in the top 50 percent of competitors for each event, by being in the top 5 all-around scores, or attaining a 31.00 all-around score.

"I have high hopes for all the gymnasts coming into the last leg of our season," said Bork.
