to Ryan Bak. For his three singles, one dinger, two runs, four RBIs and a complete game, 13-strike out performance ... drum roll please ... Ryan Bak was named the "Bud Light Player of the Game."

The celebration was short lived as the Greysox road tasks would get more ferocious. The District 7 Tourney moved to State Line League Champion, Larchwood, IA. On Sunday afternoon, July 26, the Greysox team's next foe was the home-standing Larchwood Diamonds. The Diamonds blew away the rest of the league during the regular season. The 2 p.m. start saw manager Ryan Baedke hand the ball to Mike Moran. It was more like giving some small stones to a young David, whose task was to slay this hometown Goliath.

In the top of the first inning, center fielder "Fleet" Gilbertson lead off with a line shot that was caught by the third baseman. Left fielder Reid Meierkort singled up the middle, shortstop Ryan Bak tripled to score Meierkort for the first run. Old pal, Brandon White (fresh off of his coaching stint with the Harrisburg Legion team) drew a walk.

Then right fielder Shae Williams forced White and beat out the double play throw. Next up was Ryan Baedke, doing double duty as DH and manager. Baedke deposited a 1-0 fastball over the left field fence to make the score Greysox 4 and Larchwood coming to bat.

Moran retired the first batter on a ground ball to second baseman Aaron Baedke. The next Diamond batter doubled to right, followed by a hit batter. The next two Larchwood batters would each drive in a run. The first

with a hit and the second on a sac fly to right. Moran faced eight men and wriggled off the hook with the score Greysox 4 to Larchwood's 2, at the end of the first.

Aaron Baedke lead off the second with a single, but that is all the Greysox offense would mount as Larchwood starting pitcher, Brett Walterner would retire the next nine batters in order. Moran would heroically battle into the fifth inning. Backed by solid defense, timely outs, and a few visits from the manager, Moran scattered six hits, three runs and struck out two in four-and one-third innings.

Some early defensive gems came in the second and third innings. In the second, with runners at first and third, the runner broke to steal second. Dietrich fired the ball to second baseman Baedke who fired it back to home to cut down the runner trying to steal home. In the third, Larchwood second baseman Jon Underberg singled, moved over to second on a hot shot to third that was snatched by White at third and scooped by first baseman Brett Mockler. The next batter hit a ground ball to short where Bak vacuumed it up and to Bak's amazement, Underberg tried to take third. Bak threw over to White who slapped the tag on for a rally stopping out at third.

White took over for Moran on the mound, which precipitated the moves of Mockler to third and Ryan Baedke to first. That makes three different jobs for Baedke. White scattered seven hits and gave up one run in his four-and-two-thirds innings and was awarded the win.

The defense was more than solid as Bak to Baedke

to Baedke stopped a potential rally in the sixth. Aaron Baedke rolled a double play in the seventh as he fielded the ball, stepped on second and threw over to first, where his brother stretched for another out. Larchwood stayed scoreless until the ninth, when DH Jake Schoening hit a two-pitch over the left field fence to cut the score to Greysox 9 and Larchwood 4. That would be the final as after the next man got on, another double play from White to Bak to Ryan Baedke at first squelched the rally. Two more

Diamonds got on base but Jeff "Fleet" Gilbertson hauled in the final fly to center.

Everyone was cited for a well-played game on defense. "Gilby's sliding catches and all the double plays really gave us a lift," said catcher Jason Dietrich. Dietrich had two singles on the day, Bak pitched in with a triple and a double.

The "Bud Light Player of the Game" was awarded to Ryan Baedke for his homer, two singles, four RBIs and one run scored. (Not to mention his three jobs).

So, The Greysox move into

the championship game against Garretson on Tuesday night. The Greysox will be playing ball as this story goes to press. I would take time to remind that the win over Larchwood ensures the Greysox of a berth in the state baseball tourney. I would also like to congratulate the Legion Post #1 on their victory at the state tourney in Platte.
