bases for Morecraft who delivered a two-RBI single to right field. But after Pierre answered with five runs (four unearned) in the top of the fourth, Vermillion could not make up the deficit. Post 1, 5; Clear Lake, 1 With the return of Anderson and Meierkort, Post 1 was back to full strength Saturday night, June 22, for a contest with Clear Lake. Bertram took the hill and Vermillion returned to form with a 5-1 victory that was never in question. Bertram allowed just four hits and one run, throwing all six innings and striking out six batters. Vermillion took the lead in the second on the legs of Colin Olson. Olson walked to open the inning and swiped second with ease. After the catcher's throw down to second sailed into centerfield, Olson -- a state track champion -- sped all the way around to score the game's first run. Insurance runs came in the next inning when two

walks and a hit by pitch loaded the bases for Anderson with one out. He came through, blooping a single to right field to plate Morecraft. Settles followed up Anderson with a two-RBI single back up the middle to score Huska and Meierkort. A 4-0 advantage is nearly insurmountable against Bertram, who has yet to lose this season. Settles delivered another RBI single in the fifth to plate Meierkort and ice the victory. Thunderstorms Saturday night wiped out the tournament's scheduled games on Sunday. Carrying momentum from the victory over Clear Lake, Post 1 steamrolled Canton 10-0 at Prentis Park Tuesday, June 25. Morecraft pitched a shutout in the seven-inning contest, needing only 72 pitches dispose of the Canton offense. Bertram opened the scoring with a two-RBI single and Settles drove him in with a single of his own. Olson, Haught, and Nathan Garrett each scored two runs in the rout while Anderson and Miller had two hits apiece.
