run-off election results

The votes have been tabulated for the Division III position on the SDHSAA Board of Directors. All SDHSAA member schools were entitled to vote in the election. The Division III Representative position is to be filed by a superintendent from a Division III school. The Division III schools were those schools with a 2012-2013 average daily membership of 192.853 to 7,000.

The Division III position election did not produce any candidate with a majority of the votes cast. A runoff election for this position was conducted between Mike Lodmel of Tri-Valley High School and Linda Whitney of Sanborn Central High School with Whitney being declared the winner. Whitney will fill a two-year term on the SDHSAA Board of Directors with the term commencing on July 1.

The votes have also been tabulated for the Large School Group Board of Education position on the SDHSAA Board of Directors. All SDHSAA member schools were entitled to vote in the election. The Large School Group Board of Education position is to be filed by a school board member whose schools have a 2012-2013 average daily membership of 477.070 and above.

The Large School Group Board of Education position election did not produce any candidate with a majority of the votes cast. A runoff election for this position was conducted between James Hansen from Rapid City and Sandy Klatt from Brandon with Klatt being declared the winner. Klatt will fill a four-year term on the SDHSAA Board of Directors with the term commencing on July 1.

Early lead gives Post 1 easy victory

Vermillion Legion Post 1 shut the door early on Elk Point-Jefferson Post 134, capturing an 18-1 victory on Wednesday, July 9, at Prentis Park in Vermillion.

With 15 runs in the first three innings, Vermillion left no doubt about the eventual outcome.

A two-run double by Jack Brown, an RBI single by Ty Iverson, a sacrifice fly by Billy Mount, an RBI single by Joe Mazour, an RBI double by Ethan James, an RBI single by Tanner Anderson, and an RBI single by Brown in the first inning and an RBI triple by Mazour during the second inning supplied the early offense for Vermillion.

Brown racked up four RBIs on four hits for Post 1.

Mount shut down Elk Point-Jefferson while he was on the

mound. Elk Point-Jefferson managed just one hit off of Mount, who allowed no earned runs, walked three and struck out seven during his five innings of work.

Vermillion pounded EP-J's pitching, as seven hitters combined for 13 hits, 13 RBIs and 10 runs scored.

Nate Rauch was the game's losing pitcher. He allowed nine runs in one inning, walked two and struck out none.

Vermillion added five more runs in the bottom of the third. Brown singled, plating Anderson to start the inning.

Vermillion increased its lead with three runs in the fourth. An error scored Brown and Jake Odens for the inning's first run.

Vermillion Post 1 defeats Dakota Valley 11-6

Vermillion Legion Post one and Dakota Valley Post 319 both threatened with rallies, but it was Vermillion Legion Post one that eventually took advantage of them in an 11-6 win at Prentis Park in Vermillion.

Dakota Valley out-hit Vermillion nine to eight, but Dakota Valley Post 319 stranded eight runners on base.

Tanner Anderson racked up five RBIs on one hit for Vermillion Legion Post one. He tripled in the third inning.

Ethan James recorded the win for Vermillion even though he allowed six runs over five innings. He struck out three, walked four and surrendered eight hits.

Andrew Prochello was charged with the loss. He allowed 10 runs in three innings, walked seven and struck out four.

Vermillion Legion Post 1 went up for good in the first, scoring three runs on a two-run single by Peter Haught.

One Dakota Valley run crossed the plate in the top half of the second, making the score 3-1. An error set off a Dakota Valley rally. Finally, James induced an inning-ending strike out from Brady Dam.

It didn't take long for Vermillion to respond as it scored three runs of its own in the second. Vermillion scored on a RBI double by Jack Brown.

After pushing across three runs in the top of the third,

Dakota Valley Post 319 faced just a 6-4 deficit. An RBI single by Koby Jumps, an error, and a sacrifice fly by Grant Meier gave Dakota Valley life. But, James got Alex Carter-Dickson to ground out to end the inning.

Vermillion quickly matched Dakota Valley's strong inning with a four-run inning of its own in the third. Post 1 scored on a three-run triple by Anderson and an error.

Two runs in the top of the fifth helped Dakota Valley close

its deficit to 11-6. An RBI single by Jordan Kinney and an RBI single by Carter-Dickson sparked Dakota Valley's rally. Vermillion stopped the rally after James got Dam to fly out.
