Rod Polley/Highway Superintendent met with the Board to discuss highway matters.

Wilson moved, seconded by Passick and carried to pass and adopt Resolution 2011-09 amending Resolution #11-07 regarding size of culverts on University Road.

RESOLUTION #2011-09

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION #2011-07 ADOPTING CULVERT REPLACEMENTS ON UNIVERSITY ROAD AND COYOTE STREET, BY DELETING THE CULVERT CHANGE AT 2309 UNIVERSITY ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Clay County Board of County Commissioners desires to control the amount of water backing up on the property owners at Coyote Street and University Road; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the culverts on Coyote Street and University Road are undersized, due to increased development and cannot handle the water flow effectively during a 25yr event. (2006 Clay County Drainage Study)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Clay County Commissioners that the 18"x 40" Culvert under Coyote Street be replaced with a 30" x 40" Culvert, the (18" x 40") culvert at 2017 University Road be replaced with a 30" x 40" Culvert, the (18" x 32") culvert at 2111 University Road be replaced with a 30" x 32" Culvert, the (18" x 34") culvert in the field approach north of 2011 University Road be replaced with a 30" x 34 Culvert.

surgeries in order to compete in track, and was rewarded with a state meet medal in his last opportunity.

In other boys events Cody Olson did not qualify for the finals in the 200-meter dash. In the prelims he had the 15th-best time of :24.04. It was the same situation for Ruhaak in the 400 where he had the 15th-best prelim time of :52.93.

Tea Area captured the "A" boys team state title with 77 points, followed by West Central with 61, Tri-Valley with 57 and Custer with 51.

Vermillion's girls scored team points in four events, finishing with a total of 9.33333, good enough for a tie for 28th place in the team standings.

The medley relay team of Megan Olson, Christine Epping, Paige Olson and Blair Gilkysen placed fifth in 4:31.10, scoring four team points for VHS. They bettered their preliminary time of 4:32.73, which was fourth-best among the eight finals qualifiers.

Gilkysen earned three team points with her sixth-place run in the 3200 where she was clocked in 12:19.95. A seventh-place finish in the 1600 made her a double placer. Her time of 5:33.47 added two more VHS team points.

The final one-third of a point was scored by Mackenzie Huber in the pole vault where she tied for eighth place with a leap of 7'9".

In other girls events Valerie Moos tied for 14th in the 100-meter hurdles preliminaries in :17.46. Beth Szymonski had the 10th-best discus throw in the prelims at 105'6" and the 16th-best shot put try at 32'1 3/4".
