PARTICIPANTS NEEDED FOR HEARING/AUDITORY PROCESSING STUDY

The USD Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders is seeking children ages 5-7 years who have been diagnosed with Specific Language Impairment (SLI) by a Speech-Language Pathologist or have no history of language, learning, or hearing problems to participate in a research study regarding the brainstem timing to speech stimuli.

Participation will require one listening test session at the USD Speech-Language-Hearing Clinic in Vermillion. The session will take approximately two hours and can be scheduled at your convenience (including evenings and weekends).

All participants will receive a free hearing test. Participants also will be compensated for their participation.

To participate you must:

- Have a diagnosis of Specific Language Impairment OR
- Have no history of language, learning, or hearing problems.
- Have normal hearing
- Be between 5-7 years of age
