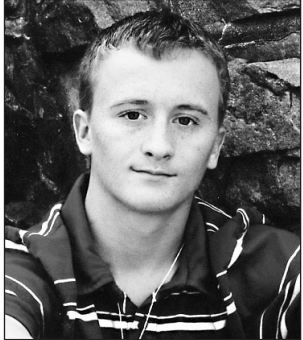
The Clay County Youth Trust Fund awards are presented annually to Clay County residents and/or Clay County 4-H members. Scholarships are funded from



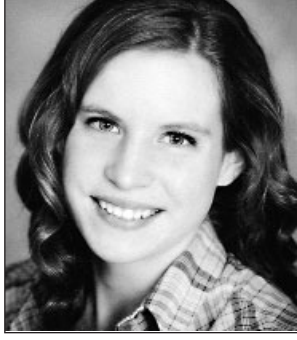

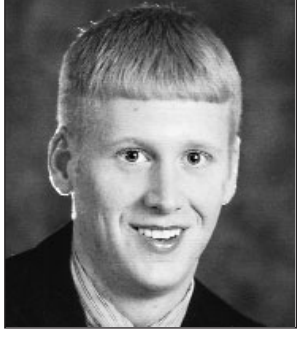
