



Make sure they understand that vour offer of \$3,000 stands as a settlement of the debt today. If they're willing to accept the offer, get a statement in writing saying that the \$3,000 represents payment in full before you cut the check. If they choose not to accept your offer, and they keep asking questions that are none of their business, just tell them to call back when they're willing to discuss terms. Then, hang up! -Dave


