Fischbach has tirelessly served the healthcare needs of thousands of student-athletes at USD since 1987. He earned his bachelor's degree from University of Nebraska-Lincoln in 1984 and his master's degree from United States Sports Academy in 1991.

Outside of USD, Fischbach has spent time working with

Special Olympics, minor league baseball, local youth athletics and athletes in the National Wheelchair Baskethall Association (NWBA). Bruce has contributed considerably to the NWBA as a tournament director, conference commissioner and member of its board of directors. He has also served the Make-A-Wish Foundation as a wish

5 Coyotes named to academic all-league team

Five members of the University of South Dakota's track and field teams were named to The Summit League's Outdoor Track and Field Academic All-League teams in a league release on Friday. The teams were voted on by each member institution's faculty athletics representatives and sports information directors.

The Coyotes landed three on the men's team with Jeff Mettler, Brant Haase and Jeff O'Connell receiving the honors. Madison Mills and Katie Wetzstein were named to the women's team.

Mettler and Haase both made the men's academic allleague team for the second

straight year and posted the only two 4.0 GPAs on the men's team. Mettler, who graduated last month with a degree in kinesiology/sports science, won the 3,000-meter steeplechase and the 5,000 at The Summit League Outdoor Championships last month. He also won the steeplechase at the Drake Relays in April.

Haase, a junior and health sciences/pre-pharmacy major, added a win in the 10,000 and a runner-up finish in the 5,000 at the league outdoor championships. He posted the

league's top time in the 5,000 at 14 minutes, 18.92 seconds. O'Connell received his first

academic all-league honor after

scoring in six events at the league championships and posting a 3.75 GPA as a physical education and coaching major. The junior won two league titles last month, winning the long jump and the 4x100.

Mills, a sophomore with a 3.70 GPA in pre-physical therapy and kinesiology/sports science, posted the nation's 19th-best pole vault mark of 13 feet, 9 1/4 inches this season. She won at the Drake Relays in April and placed second at the league outdoor championships.

Wetzstein, a sophomore in medical biology with a 3.93 GPA, scored in three events at the league championships. She

was second in the 1,500, fourth in the 5,000 and fifth in the 800. She also added a win at the Sioux City Relays in the 1,500 during the season.

To be eligible for The Summit League Academic All-League team, a student-athlete must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.30 (on a 4.0 scale), completed at least one full academic year at the current institution and participated in 50 percent of their team's competitions. The men's and women's outdoor track and field all-league teams are made up of the 10 student-athletes receiving the most votes with all ties standing.
