New Roth Conversion Rules for 2010

Starting in 2010, the IRS has relaxed the rules with regard to conversions of traditional IRA's or 401(k) plans to a Roth IRA. Prior to 2010, any conversions to a Roth IRA would be 100% taxable in the year of conversion. For 2010 conversions, the taxable income can be spread equally between tax years 2011 and 2012. 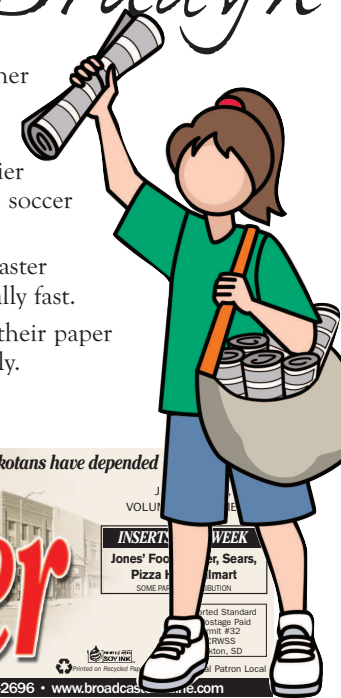
Thank You Bradyn
