Even local high school kids took part in the moment. Vermillion High School senior Sean Callahan arrived with his National Honor Society group that had a solid turnout. "It's a good thing because a lot of people have been dying from cancer, especially in Vermillion," Callahan said. "My grandpa on my dad's side died in 2007. I didn't understand what was happening that well, but I could tell he was sick." Callahan was impressed with the number of people who showed up for the relay. "I didn't think these many people would come." The top individual fundraiser was

Lucy Benitez (\$4,135) and the top community team was Kenny's Crusaders led by their team captain Zalud. Zalud gave the team's trophy to Earleen Varns, whose husband had passed away from cancer and is the namesake for the team, Jansen said. Kevin Lage, a junior and member of the USD football team, captured the "Cream Cancer" competition by raising \$61 and was honored with a small trophy and two cream pies in the face. "I feel so thankful for the amazing executive team - our faculty advisor, Bruce Fischbach, our American Cancer Society advisor, Rebecca Giddens, and all of the members of Colleges Against Cancer - for all of their handwork and dedication," Jansen said. "I feel so incredibly honored to have had the role as coordinator this past year. This has been one of the most rewarding experiences of my life, and I am so blessed to have been able to be a part of this special
