Notice is given that Hansen Irrigated Farms LLC, PO Box B, Centerville SD 57014 has filed the following applications for a water permit.

Application No. 8070-3 proposes to appropriate 1.56 cubic feet of water per second (cfs) from one well to be completed into the South Management Unit of Upper

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Vermillion Missouri Aquifer (170 feet deep) located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35 for irrigation of 96 acres located in the NE 1/4 Section 35; all in T95N-R52W. The applicant is requesting a diversion rate greater than the statutory limit of 1 cfs per 70 acres.

Application No. 8071-3 proposes to appropriate 1.0 cfs from one well to be completed into the South Management Unit of Upper Vermillion Missouri Aquifer (120 feet deep) located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35-T95N-R52W for irrigation of 51 acres located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35-T95N-R52W and E 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 2-T94N-R52W. The applicant is requesting a diversion rate greater than the statutory limit of 1 cfs per 70 acres.

Application No. 8072-3 proposes to appropriate 1.0 cfs from on well to be completed into the South Management Unit of Upper Vermillion Missouri Aquifer (100 feet deep) located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2 for irrigation of 40 acres located in the N 1/2 NW 1/4 Section 2; all in T94N-R52W. The applicant is requesting a diversion rate greater than the statutory limit of 1 cfs per 70 acres.

Pursuant to SDCL 46-2A-2, the Chief Engineer recommends APPROVAL of Application Nos. 8070-3, 8071-3 & 8072-3 because 1) unappropriated water is available, 2) existing rights will not be unlawfully impaired, 3) it is a beneficial use of water, and 4) it is in the public interest. In accordance with SDCL 46-2A-23, the Chief Engineer will act on these applications, as recommended, unless a petition is filed opposing the applications or the applicant files a petition contesting the Chief Engineer's recommendations. If a petition opposing the applications or contesting the recommendations is filed, then a hearing will be scheduled and the Water Management Board will consider these applications. Notice of the hearing will be given to the applicant and any person filing a petition.

Any person interested in opposing or supporting these applications or recommendations must file a written petition with BOTH the applicant and Chief Engineer. The applicant must file a petition if contesting the Chief Engineer's recommendations. The Chief Engineer's address is "Water Rights Program, Foss Building, 523 E. Capitol, Pierre SD 57501 (605 773-3352)" and the applicant's mailing address is given above. A petition filed by either an interested person or the applicant must be filed by March 23, 2015.

The petition may be informal, but must include a statement describing the petitioner's interest in the applications, the petitioner's reasons for opposing or supporting the applications, and the signature and mailing address of

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the petitioner or the petitioner's legal counsel, if legal counsel is obtained. ORDINANCE #2015-01**AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A COUNTY WHEEL TAX**

BE IT ORDAINED BY CLAY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

That a county tax be imposed on all licensed vehicles with wheels as defined by SDCL 32-3-1 which are registered in Clay County, at a rate not to exceed four dollars (\$4.00) per wheel on all vehicles registered in Clay County. The total vehicle tax may not exceed the sum of sixteen dollars (\$16.00) per vehicle. The tax shall be administered and collected by the County pursuant to SDCL 32-5A-1. The total sum of all proceeds from the tax shall be retained by the County and deposited in the county road and bridge fund, to be used only for highway and bridge maintenance

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and construction. The Board of County Commissioners shall, upon resolution, establish a means of distributing the revenue generated by this chapter among the County, municipalities and townships located within the county. The county wheel tax shall become effective for collection beginning August 1, 2015.
