

VERMILLION POLICE DEPARTMENT PRESS BRIEFING

04/29/14 21:40 – Caller reported a car pulling away from a convenience store with someone screaming inside. Officers located and stopped the car. They found the screaming was from a small child who was upset at parental direction and throwing a tantrum. No further action.
