We are Better than the Worst Thing We Have Ever Done

"We are better than the worst thing we have ever done.'

This is a phrase used by Sr. Helen Prejean who has walked with death row inmates for many years. I believe she is right in that we as citizens of South Dakota and as people of faith have a responsibility to begin to see our part in putting a human being to death through state sponsored executions. This is not to say that the horrible crimes committed are not devastating to the victim's families as well as the fear and shock that reverberate through society. Obviously the person committing murder deserves to have severe consequences for their behavior. Is not life in prison without parole a harsh enough consequence? Pope Francis in Oct. of 2014 said, "life in prison without
