VHS volleyball falls in district semifinals

The good news is that an exceptionally athletic class of senior girls led the way in putting together an outstanding volleyball season at Vermillion High School. The bad news is that that season ended much more prematurely than they had hoped.

The Tanagers worked all season to compile the best record in District 8A - 15 wins in all - to earn home-court advantage for the district tournament. But that edge disappeared in a hurry Tuesday night when Beresford swept Vermillion, 3-0, in their semifinal match, bringing an abrupt end to the Tanager season.

Vermillion stayed competitive throughout the close match, and when the Tanagers found themselves down two sets to none after 25-16 and 25-21 losses, it was nothing new. Twice in the past two weeks the Tanagers had rallied from 2-0 holes to win 3-2 victories, and one of those

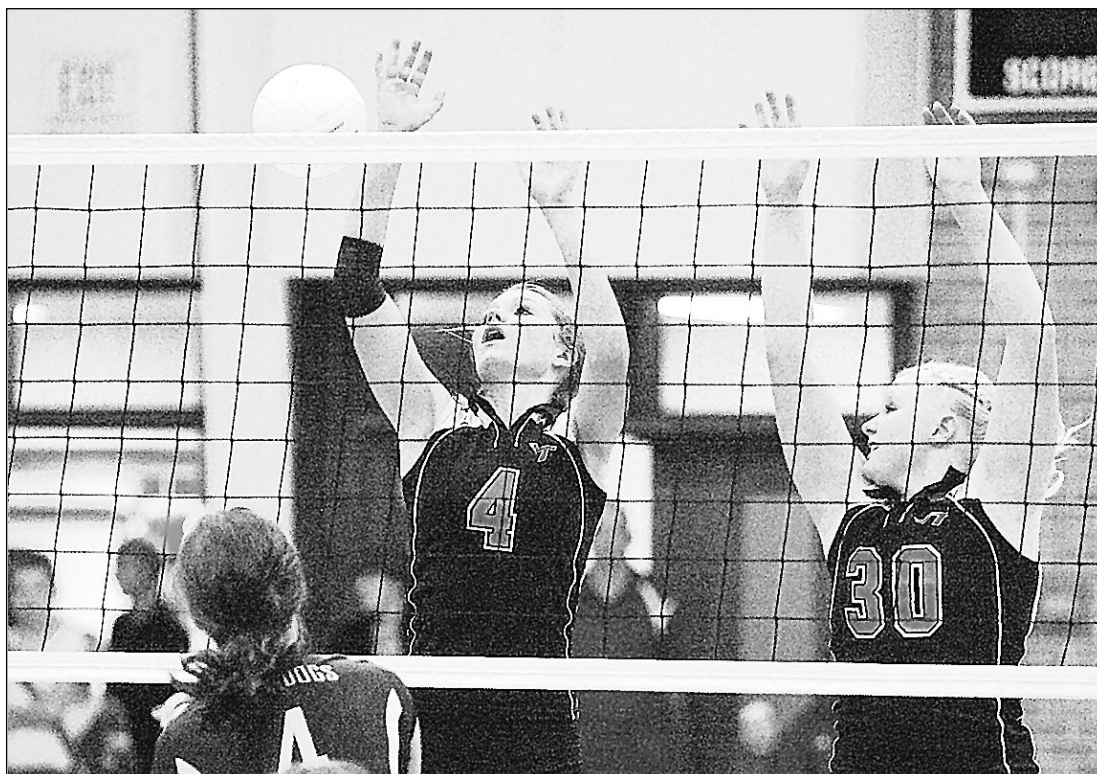
came over Beresford.

But this time the Watchdogs didn't let it happen again. Beresford captured the third set, 25-22, to end the match and the Vermillion season with a 15-9 record. Meanwhile, Beresford, with a record of only 12-14 and the fourth seed in the district, advanced to the championship match last night (Thursday) at defending champion Elk Point-Jefferson's home court. EP-J swept Dakota Valley, 3-0, in Tuesday's other semifinal.

In the Tanagers' match Katie Herrera had six kills, two digs and three blocks. Kylie Fischbach posted two kills, 10 digs, 10 set assists and a service ace. Lizzy Bye compiled 16 digs and two kills.

Seniors who saw their volleyball careers come to a halt were Emily McClelland, Bye, Fischbach, Jonna Lynch, Sami Girard, Bailey Carlson, Lexi Regnerus, Beth Szymanski and Kelly Amundson.

The Tanagers ended their regular season with a 3-0 loss at Elk Point-Jefferson last Thursday, dropping sets by 15-25, 18-25 and 20-25 scores.

Iowa State tops USD in women's swim dual

Senior Lizz Hoffman and freshman Corey Wannamaker each earned wins, while the South Dakota 400 freestyle relay was also victorious to lead the Coyote women's swimming and diving team in a 209-91 loss to Big 12 Conference foe Iowa State Friday night at the DakotaDome pool in Vermillion.

Hoffman captured the win in the 200 freestyle with a time of 2:08.24. She also added a second-place finish in the 50 freestyle with a time of 27.23. Hoffman now has four event wins in two duals so far this season.

Wannamaker picked up her second event win of 2011-12 with a victory in the 100 freestyle with a time of 1:00.01.

The Coyotes 400-meter freestyle relay was victorious with a time of 4:04.76, just .47 seconds away from the school record. That consisted of Wannamaker,

sophomore Mariah Anderson, freshman Lydia Engberg and junior Kaitlyn Jefferson.

The Coyotes' 200 medley relay took second with a time of 2:03.12. That consisted of Anderson, junior Shannon Mocerri, freshman Molly Knowles and Hoffman.

Mocerri was second in the 100 breaststroke at 1:15.97, while Knowles was second in the 200 butterfly at 2:30.91. Senior Janine James was second in the 1-meter diving at 223.30. Freshman Paige Stavely was second in the 200 backstroke at 2:27.19.

USD women's soccer falls to ORU

Junior Erin Bello recorded the first hat trick of her career with three goals, but it wasn't enough as Oral Roberts topped the South Dakota women's soccer team, 5-3, in Summit League action Saturday night in Tulsa, OK. The contest ended the 2011 season for the Coyotes.

Bello scored three times - her third goal gave the Coyotes a 3-2 lead in the 57th minute - and finished the season with a team-high five goals. Freshman Jess Nieman added an assist.

The game featured a combined 42 shots in the game - Oral Roberts had 22 and

South Dakota had 20. Bello had a game-high nine shots, including five on goal, while freshman Lauren Bennett added five shots, including three on goal.

Freshman Kayla Wegman started the game in net for the Coyotes and had a career-high six saves. Freshman Mackenzie Viktor played the second half and had one save.

The contest was a seesaw battle for much of the night. South Dakota had a 15-11 edge in shots in the second half.

The Coyotes had no seniors on their active roster - Sami Spokas was a medical redshirt and did not play in 2010 - and

have just two juniors. They had an NCAA Division I high of 21 freshmen on their roster.
