SDSU claims must-win game at USD

Facing a must-win in front of a more-than-capacity crowd on the road, the South Dakota State football team responded to adversity after adversity.

And came away with a rivalry victory.

The Jackrabbits committed two key mistakes in the final 4:34 but made the biggest play of the day on an interception return to beat the University of South Dakota 27-12 in Saturday afternoon's much-anticipated showdown at the DakotaDome.

When the dust had settled, the Jackrabbits (7-4, 4-3) kept their post-season hopes alive.

"Obviously it was a big game. We knew we had to win these next two games," said SDSU receiver Jason Schneider, who had 88 yards and two touchdowns receiving.

"Coach Stig talked about being in a world series and being down one to three, and we have to win the next two games," he added. "And that's our goal every year. It was a big game, I'm just glad we came out on top."

In dramatic fashion, no less. For a game 10 years in waiting in Vermillion, the final four minutes and 34 seconds had enough twists and turns to satisfy the crowd of 10,845 — well beyond the dome capacity.

Down 20-12, the Coyotes (4-7, 3-4) blocked an SDSU field

goal try but could not capitalize. Kevin Earl was sacked on 4th & 11 by R.C. Kilgore, who came untouched through the middle.

On the second play for the Jacks, though, standout Zach Zenner fumbled the ball and Devin Taverna's recovery set up USD deep in SDSU territory. On the first play from scrimmage,

Earl's pass to the left sideline was intercepted by Winston Wright and returned 80 yards for a game-clinching touchdown.

The post-game joke was that typically in that situation, a defensive player would take a knee.

"It's something that we talk every week, take a knee during

two minutes," Wright said. "I caught it, saw that I was in bounds, looked up at the clock and saw there was three minutes."

Two plays and 1:23 later, the Jackrabbits were able to celebrate.

Wall leads North Dakota women past USD

North Dakota held Summit League-leading scorer Nicole Seekamp without a field goal and combined to block 10 shots in a 65-61 non-conference win over former rival USD Sunday afternoon at the Betty Engelstad Sioux Center.

Former Dakota Valley standout Allyssa Wall had 10 points, eight rebounds and five blocked shots for North Dakota (1-2). Madi Buck had a game-high 18 points, with Mia Loyd netting 17 points. Megan Lauck added 13 points in the victory.

Tia Hemiller scored a career-high 16 points and had four

assists to lead USD (1-3). Margaret McCloud posted a double-double off the bench, finishing with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Nicole Seekamp was held without a field goal, but had a team-best five assists.

USD continues its road trip to start the season on Thursday, playing Drake at The Pentagon in Sioux Falls. The game is a home game for the Coyotes, but will be the fifth straight contest outside of the DakotaDome for USD.
