PIERRE, S.D. – Gov. Dennis Daugaard is currently seeking applications for two spring 2016 Governor's Office internships in Pierre. The positions will be paid and run from early January through May 2016.

Students who are interested in receiving credit should also apply. The Governor's staff is open to working with individual universities and professors to secure credit for the internship program.
