Commissioner Minutes

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday August 28, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. Members present: Wilson, Powell, Passick, Packard and Kephart.

Kephart moved, seconded by Passick and carried to approve the agenda as presented.

Minutes of the August 9th meeting were approved with a motion by Wilson, seconded by Packard and carried.

Rod Polley/Highway Superintendent met with the Board to discuss highway matters.

Gasoline quotes were submitted. Passick moved, seconded by Kephart and carried to accept low quote from Brunick Service, Vermillion for \$3.58 per gal. (1600

Propane quotes were submitted. Wilson moved, seconded by Kephart and carried to accept low quote from Longs Propane, Yankton for \$.96 per gal.

The Board discussed 316th Street with Rolling Hills Est. residents and Vermillion Township Board members regarding procedure for repairing /construction of their township road. Teddi Gertsma/instructed the Board that the County does not have legal authority to maintain plan or pay for anything related to township business. The county could contract with the township to do work once the road is brought up to county standards with the township paying for the work preformed. It was recommended by the States Attorney that the laws need to be researched as to the procedure for the residents to meet with the Township Board and formally submit their request

to them and from there the Township could formally petition the County Commissioners for taking over the road or contracting for repairs in the future. The County is currently not in position to make any decision until appropriate laws are confirmed for the process to follow.
