Join us for an evening with newspaper columnist and Internet sensation Marilyn Hagerty, 86, as she receives the 2012 Al Neuharth Award for Excellence in the Media. Hagerty, who writes columns

for the North Dakota Grand Forks Herald, drew widespread media attention earlier this year when her straightforward feature story about the opening of the first Olive Garden restaurant in Grand Forks went viral on the Internet. Her long and storied journalism career included time at the University of South Dakota, where she was Al Neuharth's first editor at the student newspaper, The Volante.



The award, recognizing lifetime achievement, is named for USA TODAY and Freedom Forum founder Al Neuharth, a South Dakota native and 1950 USD journalism graduate, who will be on campus to honor

Hagerty as a model journalist dedicated to serving local communities through consistently fair, truthful and relevant coverage.
