After growing up in Vermillion, Christensen left town to attend college in Minnesota where she earned degrees in clothing design and textiles. Eventually she began working for various clothing companies until moving to Colorado Springs with her husband.

There Christensen latched on with Terra Verde, a clothing store/boutique, and rose from temporary sales person to general manager after 16 years.

She considered staying on longer and exploring other, expansive options.

"It's a wonderful business and it was a hard decision to leave," she said. "I loved my boss, I loved my coworkers, and I loved my customers.

"But my family was back here and I lost my mom." away in March of

Her mother Ann passed Alzheimer's and she returned to Vermillion to be closer to her father Marvin and other family members.

Then realization sunk in when she saw her 3 ½ yearold son in the foreground of living in Vermillion. "I want him to grow up here," she said.

Then she also got a little bit of whimsy: "And I also thought there could be a little bit of a

Terra Verde here." Thus the Blue Monarch was born.

"I have always liked butterflies because they are a symbol of transition, transformation, metamorphosis, Christensen said. "They change in a comfortable way. Seasons change, clothing changes, so it all seems to fit with a clothing

store. "Blue is for my mother who passed away in March of Alzheimer's and it was her favorite color. And Monarchs are beautiful. I always loved the image of the Blue Monarch."

So hoping to make women beautiful via clothing, jewelry, scarves, hats, gloves, etc. Christensen will try to wield her connections made over nearly two decades to bring quality products home.

"It was an education beyond anything I got in college," she said of her work experience. "I developed a clientele and discovered what works. Now I know what works."

Visits to Denver or Minneapolis will be more of the norm due to location, but Christensen plans to take product scouting trips to Las Vegas, Los Angeles, and New York when she can and sees fit.

Currently she is the only employee, but that will change.

"I need to get a feeling for traffic, but one day I will have to get some more product," she said. "So then I will need someone to watch the store when I'm gone."


